- ☐ All Choir and Band students will be provided with a SmartMusic subscription at no cost.

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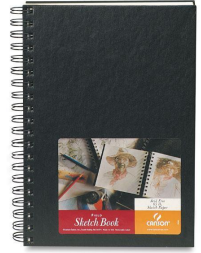
Art Supplies (Art Students only):

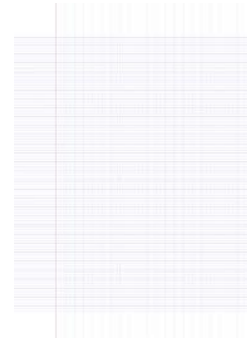
Spanish D students only

- ☐ Fully loaded pencil case

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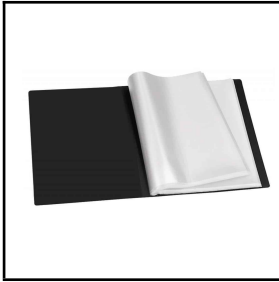
French B students only

ASD Dress Code

Our dress code provides guidance for students and parents on suitable attire for our school's learning environment. While ASD does not have a school uniform (except for P.E. clothing), all students are expected to dress in a manner that reflects our school values and contributes to an academic atmosphere.

- Students' clothes should cover their body from (and including) their shoulders down to three inches above the knee, as well as the waist. Wearing clothes with holes or that are see-through in this area is not acceptable. Also, underwear should not be visible.
- Jewelry, glasses, and t-shirt decorations and logos should be culturally sensitive and not offensive or inappropriate. Hats and sunglasses may only be worn outdoors.
- Distracting personal devices, such as cell phones and smartwatches, should not be worn or used during the school day. If they are brought to school, they should be turned off and put away in a student's locker.

If a student's dress does not comply with these guidelines, they will be asked to change. If the student does not have alternate clothing, parents will be contacted. Please note that our dress code remains in effect during school-sponsored activities, including school socials and field trips.

Note: Dress Code During P.E.

Students are required to wear a P.E. shirt and appropriate athletic bottoms for their physical education classes. Middle school students who still have last year's P.E. uniform (and it still fits) are welcome to wear it during this year's classes.
