General Essentials (For All Classes)

- **Sturdy Binder with Divider Tabs** to organize your subject materials & notes
 - You could have several smaller binders if you prefer to separate subjects.
- **Lined Paper:** 2 packs of college-ruled filler paper.
- **Pens & Pencils:** A consistent supply of blue or black pens and #2/HB pencils.
- **Highlighters:** A pack of 3–4 different colors for active reading and note-taking.
- **Planner/Agenda:** Whether digital or paper, you need a dedicated place to track deadlines.

Subject-Specific Requirements

Subject Area	Items Needed
Mathematics	-TI-Nspire CX II CAS (including II-C CAS or II-T CAS) TI-Nspire CX II (including CX II-T) -Notebook with graph paper -12-inch ruler -A consistent supply of green pens
Science	Composition notebook (lab-specific) and a dedicated folder for lab reports
English / Humanities	– Pack of 3x3 Post-it notes and/or tabs for annotating texts – A pocket folder for keeping essays and handouts
World Languages - French	A4-size stapled/spiral notebook with single-lined ruling with margin
Arabic / MSA	A thin (½ inch) binder and a set of index cards for vocabulary Arabic notebook (From right to left) A4 A pocket folder for keeping essays
PE	Athletic shoes, swim cap, bathing suit (1 piece or rash guard shirt for females), swim goggles optional

Technology & Digital Tools

- **School-issued Laptop & Charger:** Ensure your device is fully charged each morning.
- **Earbuds/Headphones:** For independent work or language lab listening exercises.
- **Reusable Water Bottle:** To stay hydrated throughout the day (many classrooms are "laptop-safe" zones).

Pro-Tip for Students: Don't feel like you have to buy everything at once! Start with the general essentials, and your specific teachers will let you know during the first week if there are any unique items required for their specific projects.
